
Prepare the RFID reader for use

1 Charge the reader's battery using the included micro-USB cable.

2 Turn on both the reader and its Bluetooth by pressing and holding the on/off button.


Once Bluetooth has been activated, a blue indicator light displays on the top of the reader, near the on/off button.



Connect with Allegro

In the Bluetooth COM application, tap Discover Devices and select iID PENsolid. Note the COM port used; you will need to select it in step 3.



Select COM Port in Allegro Periodic Survey Application

- On the Allegro, open the Periodic Survey applications. Tap **View** and then **Options** and then the **RFID** tab.
- 2 Select microsensys from the list in the Model field.
- 3 Select the COM port that was assigned to the reader in step 2.
